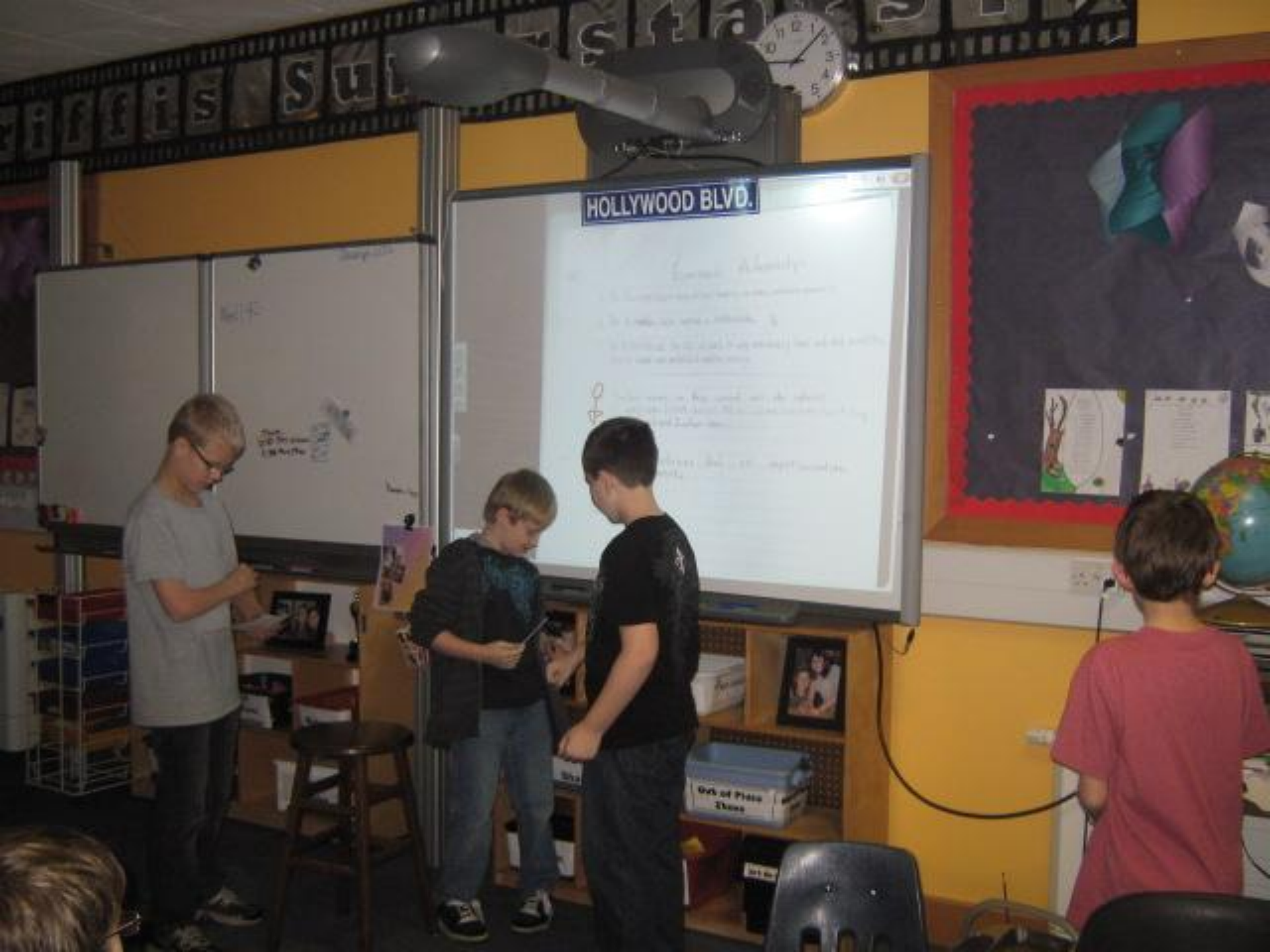

1. The main idea of a text is the central point or message that the author wants to convey. It is usually found at the beginning or end of a text.

2. Supporting details are the facts, examples, and evidence that the author uses to support the main idea. They are usually found in the middle of a text.

3. The author's purpose for writing a text is the reason why the author wrote the text. It can be to inform, persuade, entertain, or describe.

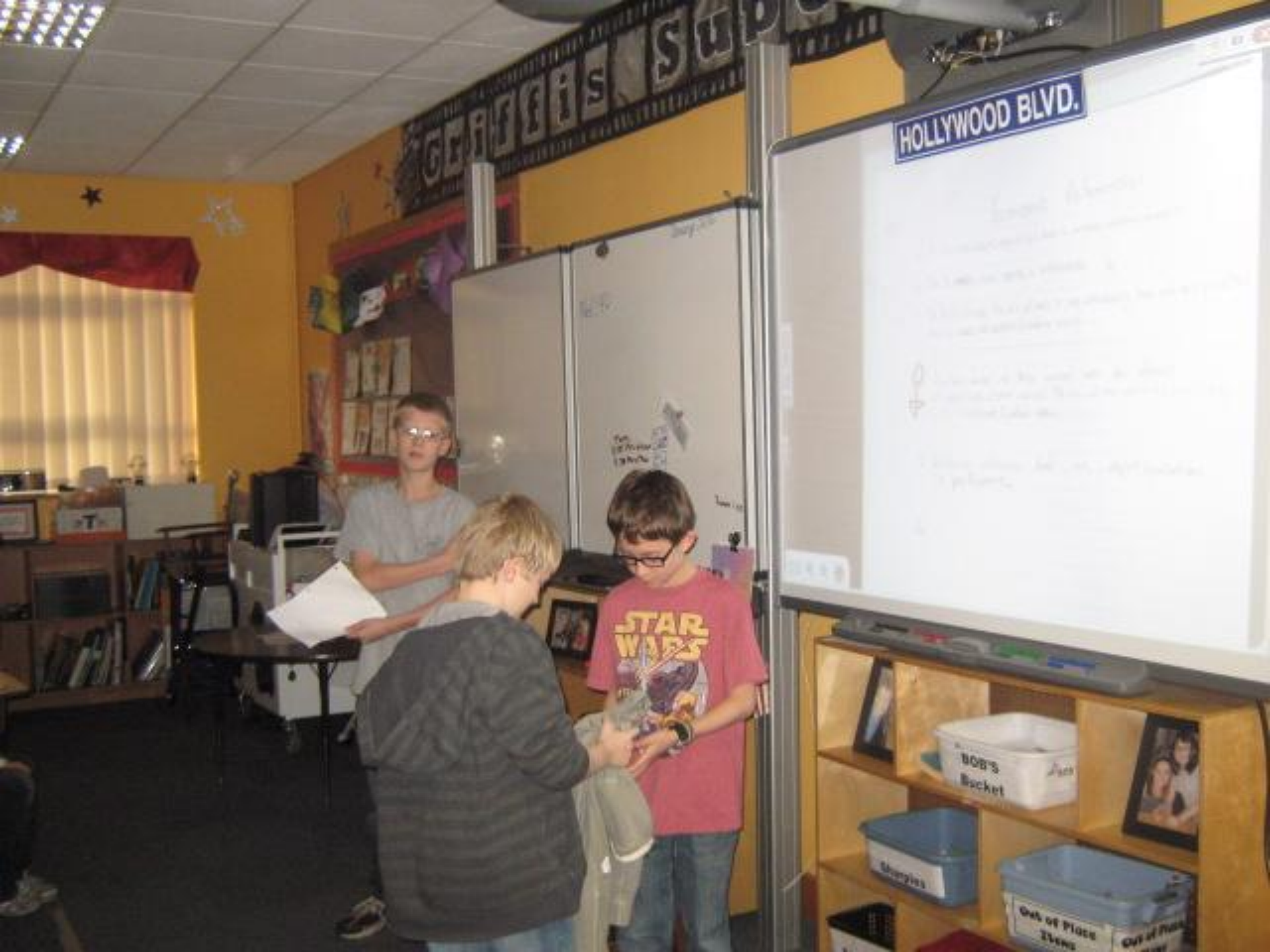

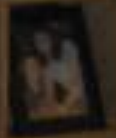
